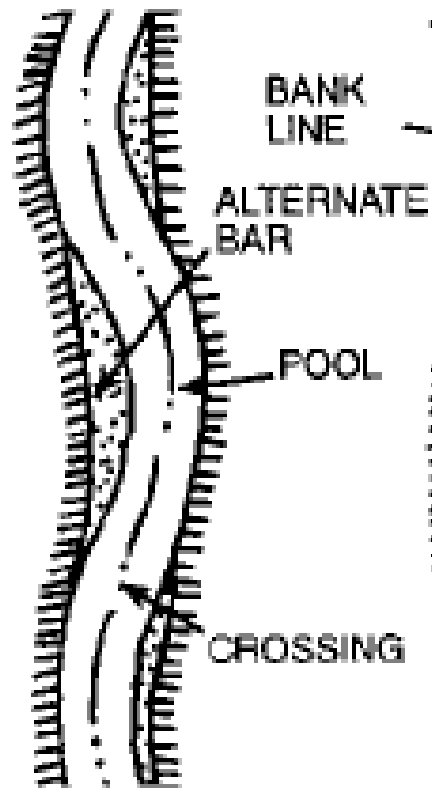

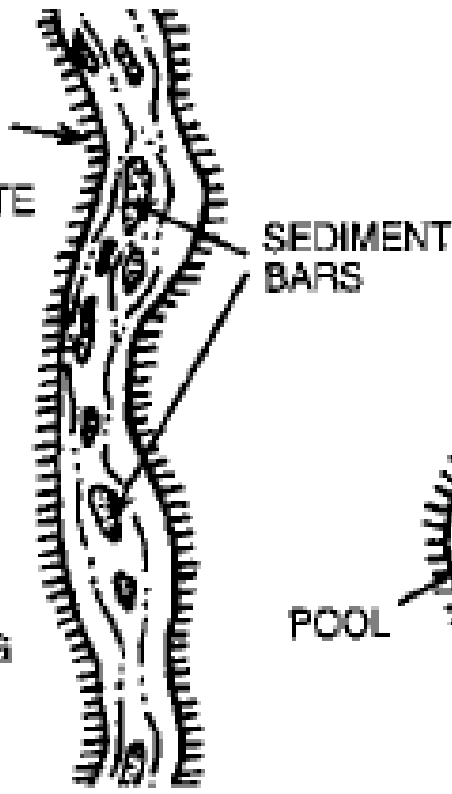

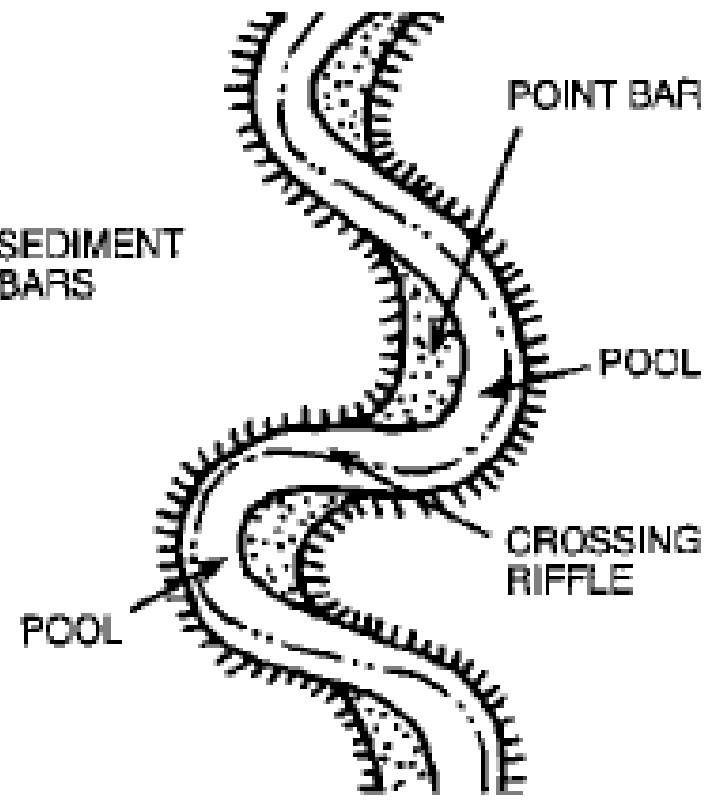
**STRAIGHT CHANNEL**

**BRAIDED CHANNEL**

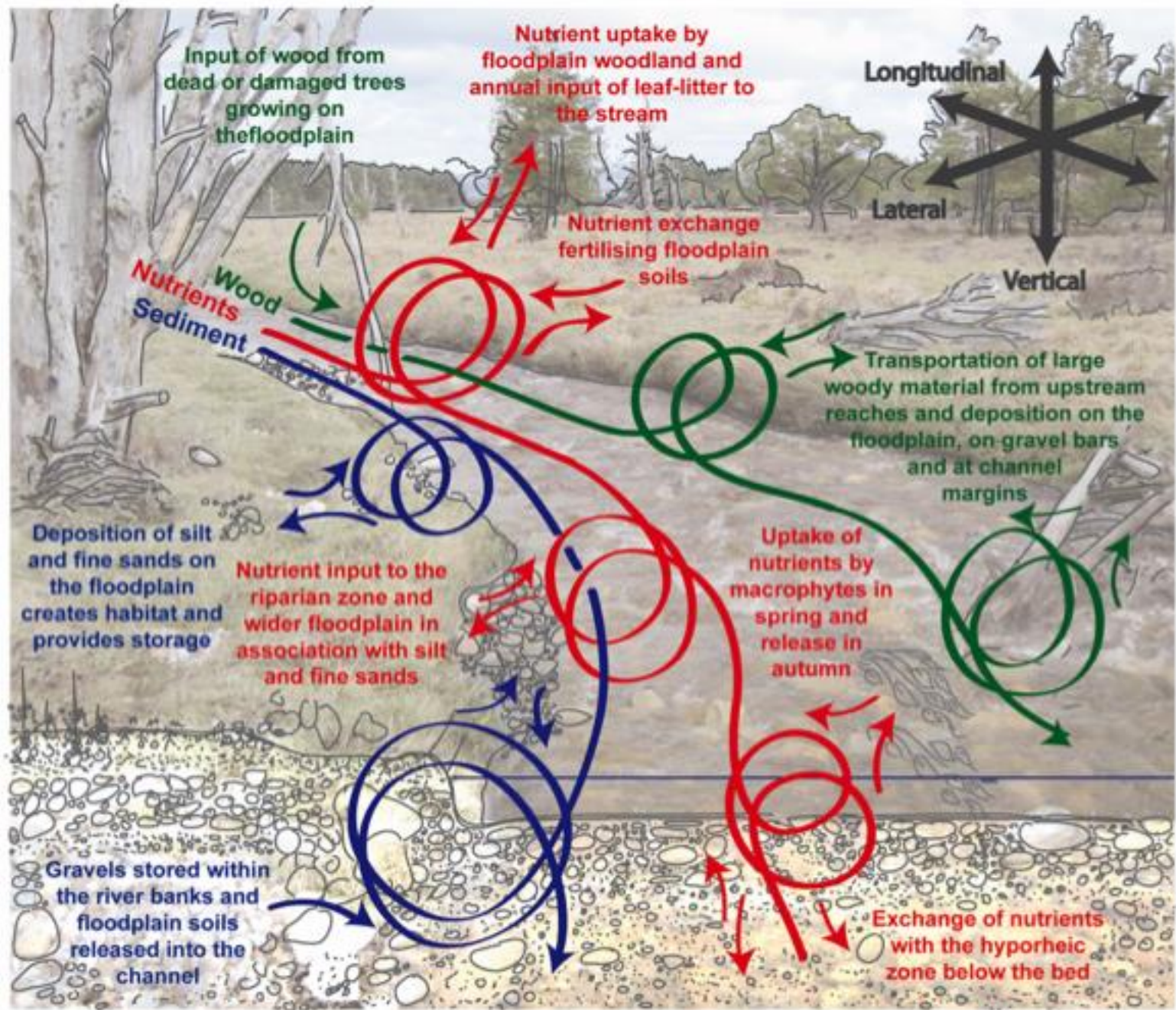


**MEANDERING CHANNEL**  
SINUOSITY >1.5



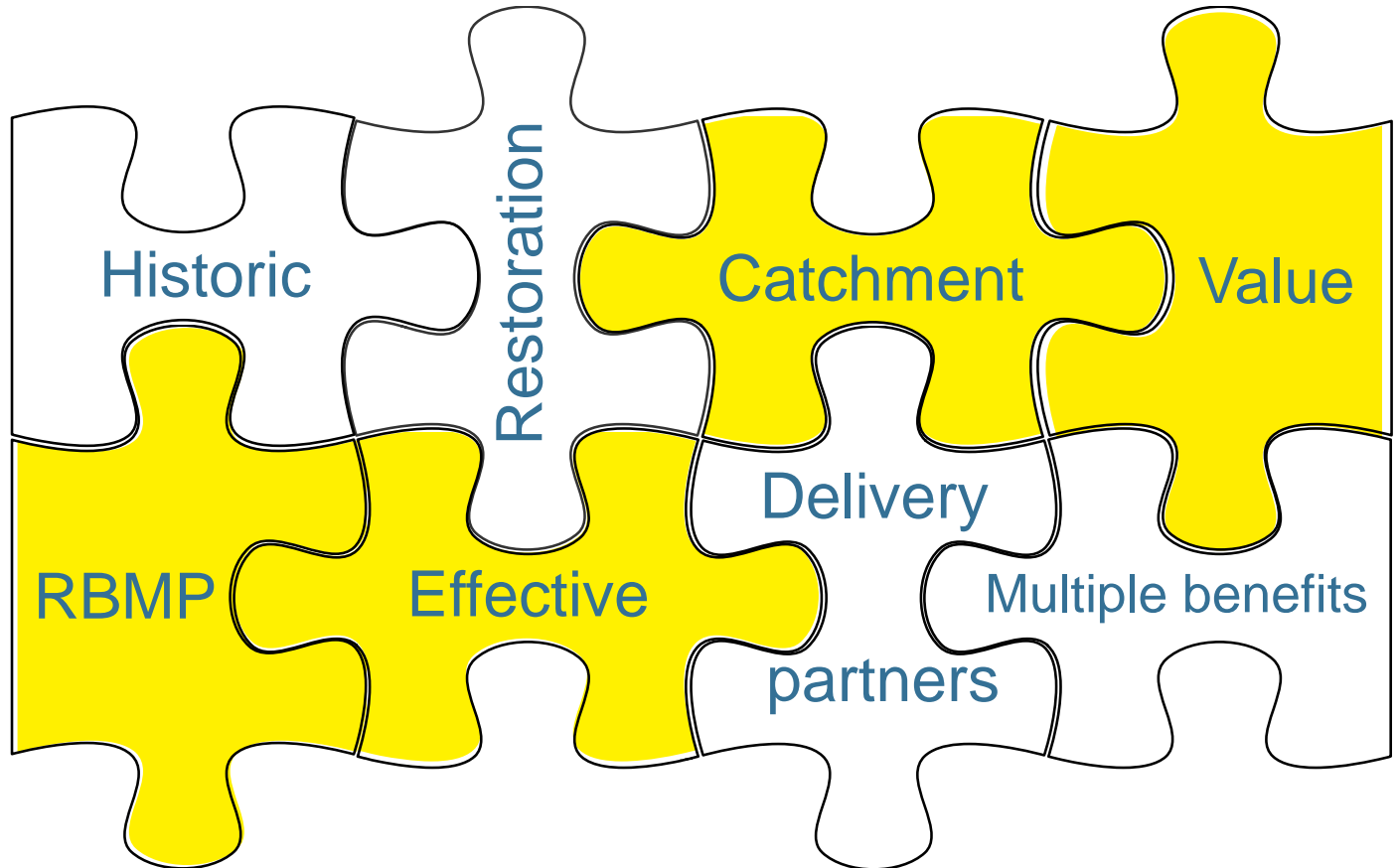

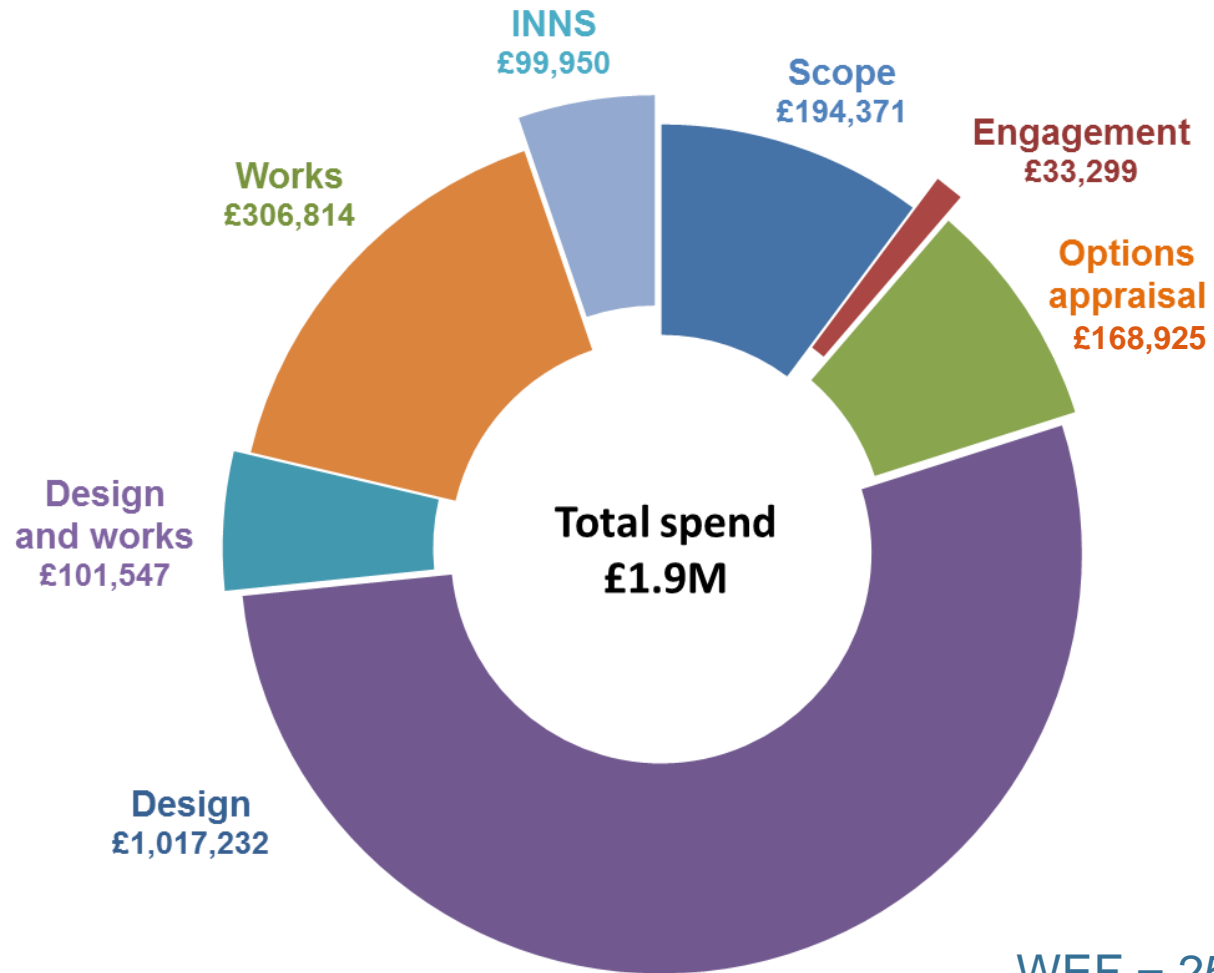

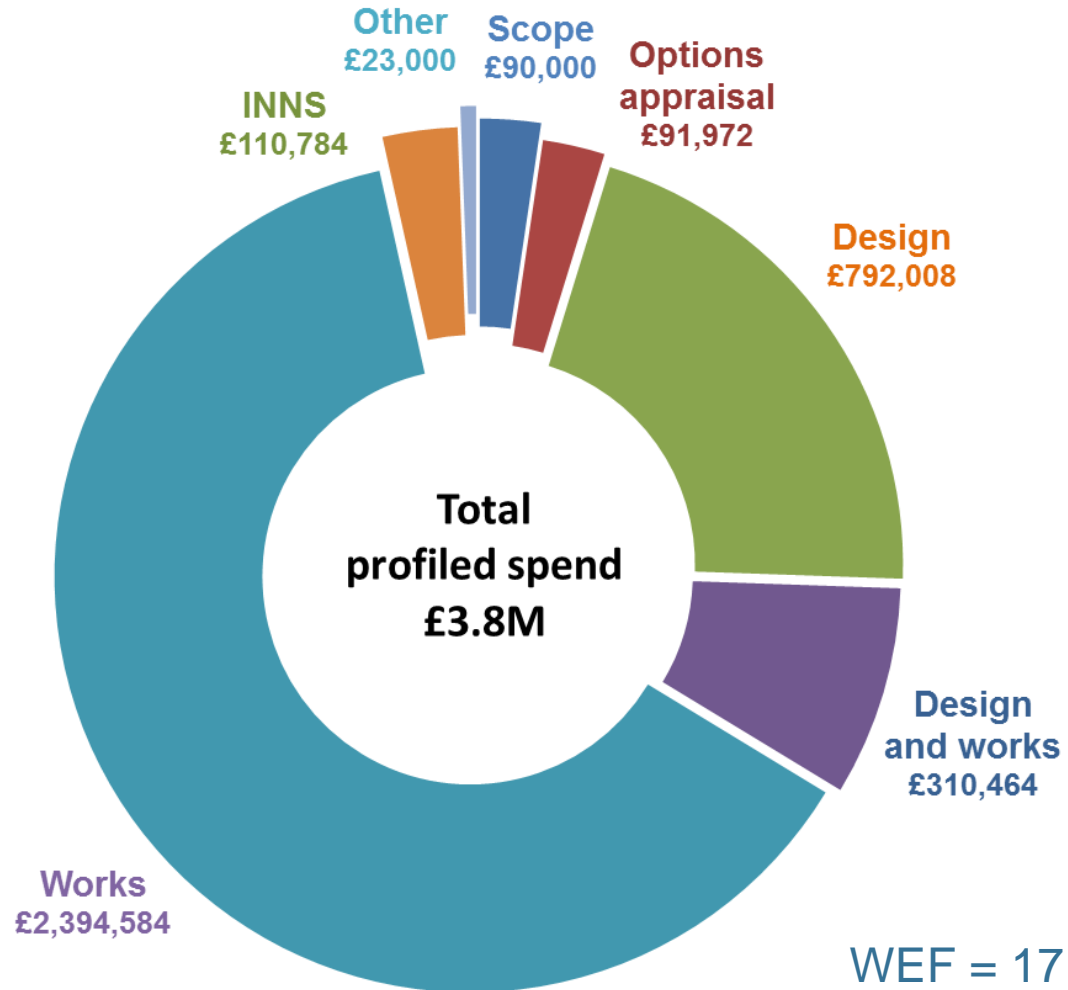
